### Incidents Occurring In or Near the City of Belle Meade

7-31-17	Suspicious Vehicle	600 Block of Lynwood Blvd.	Report of a black Chevy Blazer parked in the grass in front of a residence for around 45 minutes. Officers checked and it was a survey company working at a neighbor's residence.
8-2-17	Suspicious Subjects	4500 Block of Millrace Ln.	Call received from Metro Dispatch. Complainant saw 2 male subjects walking around her residence via a security camera. Officers checked the residence. Subjects were gone on the arrival of officers.
8-3-17	Officer Investigation	700 Block of Belle Meade Blvd.	Car alarm activation. Officers checked the vehicle. The vehicle was secured and no apparent reason for the alarm activation.
8-4-17	Officer Investigation	1300 Block of Chickering Rd.	While on patrol, an officer came upon vehicles blocking part of roadway. Officer warned subjects about required flagman.
8-5-17	Traffic Stop	Harding Pl./Enquirer Ave.	Vehicle stopped for a traffic violation. After stopping the vehicle fled and later stopped near Finezza's on Harding Rd. The driver and passengers fled the vehicle. One passenger was arrested for resisting stop, simple possession, and underage possession of alcohol. Subject was transported to the Hill Detention Center. The officer obtained warrants on the driver for felony evading.
8-6-17	Traffic Stop	5109 Harding Rd.	Vehicle stopped for a traffic violation. The driver was arrested for driving under the influence. The driver was transported to the Hill Detention Center.
