Date	Incident	Address	Description
9-4-17	Traffic Stop	Harding Pl./Lindawood Dr.	Vehicle stopped for a traffic violation. The driver was arrested for driving under the influence, implied consent, and simple possession. The driver was transported to the Hill Detention Center for booking.
