9-12-16	Officer Investigation	Page Rd./Belle Meade Blvd.	Report of a black SUV driving wreck-less towards Belle Meade Blvd. Vehicle almost struck 2 or 3 vehicles. No contact/Gone on arrival.
9-13-16	Suspicious Vehicle	Sunnyside Dr.	Report of a suspicious burgundy Pontiac with a temporary tag. The vehicle pulled into a couple of driveways and the complainant thought it was suspicious. No contact/Gone on arrival.
9-15-16	Suspicious Subject	400 Block of Lynwood Blvd.	Report of a suspicious black male driving a 4 door sedan. Subject was located. The subject was a solicitor and he was warned about the required permit.
