All recycling will now require BLUE bags.

Come by city hall and pick up your FREE BLUE RECYCLE BAG STARTER KIT!

- Continue to use the same trash/recycle containers and put trash in black or white bags and recycle in BLUE bags. <u>The contractor is not accepting glass for recycle at this time. Please put glass in the trash bags.</u>
- If you desire a second pick-up day each week, you will need to set this up with Franklin Disposal, 615-794-8964. They will invoice you directly for this extra service.

PUBLIC SAFETY UPDATE - On June 2, 2017 during the early morning hours, Belle Meade Police interrupted a car burglary operation in the area of Parmer Park. While checking a vehicle,

the officer observed items that raised his suspicions. Upon closer examination, the officer observed what appeared to be an illegal substance lying on the seat of the vehicle. An immediate search of the area was conducted and as the investigation continued, a suspect was identified and located. Ultimately, the suspect cooperated with our detective and confessed to illegally entering several other parked vehicles in our City as well as other West Nashville area locations. The investigation led to the identification of one juvenile and two young adults. Of the car burglaries that had occurred in the Metro area, several stolen items were recovered. Metro has charged the suspects with multiple counts of theft as a result of the great work by the Belle Meade officers. It should be noted that of the six vehicles in Belle Meade that may have been rummaged through, only one had a small amount of cash taken. I believe the Park Smart campaign and the repeated recommendation to our residents to remove items of value from their parked vehicles prevented additional thefts that night. I am very proud of our residents for Parking Smart! Please continue to lock your vehicles while they are unattended and immediately call in suspicious activity to us at 615-297-0241.

Please remember to take advantage of our **House Check Services** while you are out of town. Officers will provide extra patrol of your residence even if you are going to be gone for one day.





MAYOR HUNT AND METRO PROPERTY ASSESSOR SIGN CERTIFIED TAX RATE CALCULATION



On Tuesday, June 7th, Mayor Jim Hunt and Metro Property Assessor Vivian Wilhoite signed the Calculation Form for Belle Meade's new Certified Property Tax Rate of \$0.25705. The new rate was initially calculated by the Metro Assessor's office, then verified and approved by the State. The City must adopt the approved rate and can then proceed, if it so

first reading of the Ordinance to set the property tax rate at the same rate as the Certified Rate. Second and final reading of the Ordinance will be at the Board meeting on June 21st at 4pm.

What is the Certified Tax Rate? To prevent local governments from realizing a windfall in tax revenues because of a reappraisal, state law requires that a Certified Tax Rate (CTR) be set after each mass reappraisal. The law, also known as "The Truth in Taxation Law," provides that the certified tax rate must not raise more revenues — except on new construction - than in the prior tax year. However, counties and cities still have the option to adjust their tax rate at any time, depending on the cost of services and other fiscal needs and providing they follow proper public notice and public hearing procedures.
