Mrs. Patsy Harvey of 219 Jackson Blvd was in attendance to give an update on the data collected from the neighbors on the street. She contacted 23 neighbors via email concerning their opinion of lowering the speed from 30 miles per hour to 25 miles per hour. Seventeen responded in favor of lowering the speed limit. Chief Eads reported that a 10 day survey was conducted and the average speed was almost 30 miles per hour. He mentioned that there was an estimated 2000 cars using that road per day. Clay Staley of 305 Jackson and Rebecca Collins of 205 spoke in favor of some type of speed deterrent, including crosswalks, an additional stop sign, or speed bumps. The Commissioners agreed to continue to discuss further action and decide in the next month.
