1. Ordinance 2016-1, Amend Zoning Code to Allow the Use of Churches and Other Places of Worship for Specific Charitable and Fund Raising Activities, on second reading

Requires churches or places of worship to request a permit for any activities they wish to hold on their premises during a twelve-month period.

2. Consideration of Permit for Specific Charitable and Fund Raising Activities, presented by St. George's Episcopal Church

Laura Zabaski and Sam Adams of St. Georges Episcopal Church were in attendance to submit a permit request for the farmer's market that the church plans to host. They outlined the specifics regarding their weekly event. Dates, hours of operation, and location were given. Thornburg asked about how they would advertise. Mayor Hunt suggested use of West Meade News and using an email blast to notify residents in the surrounding area about the event. Thornburg also made a suggestion to advertise that proceeds will go to local charity and food organizations. The event will be limited to no more than 20 vendors and up to three food trucks at a time. Depending on the success of the event this year, the permit will be re-visited next year to make any changes.

3. Ordinance 2016-3, Amending Anti-Noise Regulations, on second reading
 Change ending time of noise standards from 10:00 PM to 11:00 PM on Friday nights and Saturday nights.

4. Ordinance 2016-04, Close, Vacate, and Abandon a Portion of the Right of Way of a 50' Street Called Redwing Avenue at the Rear of 121 Westhampton Pl and 400 Sunnyside Drive



Motion to approve: Bogle


