ORDINANCE NO. 16

AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE CERTAIN ROADS AS ARTERIAL
 HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: In order to promote traffic safety within the corporate limits of the City of Belle Meade, the following roads within the City Limits shall be designated as Arterial Highways, and traffic on them shall have the right of way over traffic on roads entering and leaving these roads.

- a. The Harding Road, being the main State Highway, shall have the right of way over all intersections within the City.
- b. Belle Meade Boulevard, the double parkway, shall have right of way from Harding Road to Percy Warner Park.
- c. Jackson Boulevard shall have right of way, except where it crosses Belle Meade Boulevard.
- d. Lynnwood Boulevard, except that portion lying between its intersections with Lynnwood Terrace, shall have right of way from Harding Place to the Harding Road. Lynnwood Terrace shall have right of way throughout its length.
- e. Westview Avenue shall have right of way from Lynnwood Boulevard to Harding Place.

Section 2: All of these roads so designated in the preceding sections, shall be known and considered as Arterial Highways, and shall be so marked with the proper road signs in accord with the requirements of the State Department of Highways. This is to promote traffic safety and the public welfare.

Section 3: Any vehicle of any type, before entering an Arterial Highway, shall be brought to a full stop.
