


ORDINANCE NO. 51-8

AN ORDINANCE TO CLOSE, VACATE AND ABANDON A PORTION OF A CERTAIN STREET OR RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE, KNOWN AS CHEROKEE CIRCLE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE as follows:


SECTION 1. That certain portion of a dedicated but unpaved street, shown on the major street plan of the City of Belle Meade, filed in the Register's Office of Davidson County, Tennessee, on May 10, 1946, as Cherokee Circle, which extends from the southerly margin of Iroquois Avenue in a southerly direction 850 feet more or less, to the northerly margin of Sheppard Place, and being 50 feet in width, is hereby declared closed, vacated and abandoned.
