ORDINANCE NO. 56-2

AN ORDINANCE TO CLOSE, VACATE AND ABANDON A PORTION OF A CERTAIN STREET OR RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE KNOWN AS HOWELL PLACE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That certain portion of a dedicated but unpaved street,
shown on the major street plan of the City of Belle Meade, filed in
