

ORDINANCE NO. 56-2


AN ORDINANCE TO CLOSE, VACATE AND ABANDON A
 PORTION OF A CERTAIN STREET OR RIGHT-OF-WAY IN
 THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE KNOWN AS HOWELL PLACE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1. That certain portion of a dedicated but unpaved street, shown on the major street plan of the City of Belle Meade, filed in the Register's Office of Davidson County, Tennessee, on May 10, 1946, to which plan reference is made, which extends from the easterly margin of Cherokee Circle at its intersection with Howell Place in an easterly direction approximately 200 feet to a dead end, and being 50 feet in width, is hereby declared closed, vacated and abandoned.
