

ORDINANCE NO. 65-1

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY, TENNESSEE, TO PROVIDE THAT ALL FUNDS WHICH WOULD OTHERWISE ACCRUE TO THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE MAY BE PAID BY THE STATE OF TENNESSEE TO SAID METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT FOR USE IN CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION, AND MAINTENANCE OF SCHOOLS PROVIDED BY SAID METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO NEGOTIATE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE TOWARD SUCH AGREEMENT AND TO REPORT AND RECOMMEND SAME TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR APPROVAL; AND TO PROVIDE FOR EVIDENCE FOR SUCH APPROVAL BY RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That, whereas the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County presently provides, through its Department of Public Education, for primary and secondary schools for the education of residents of all Davidson County including the City of Belle Meade; and

WHEREAS, It appears that additional funds will be required in the future to carry out the program proposed for said system, and the levying of an additional sales tax on all transactions subject thereto in the area of said Metropolitan Government has been approved, subject to approval by the voters of said area on March 22, 1965, which approval has likewise been voted and certified; and

WHEREAS, The law of Tennessee providing for the imposition of such additional tax, TCA Section 67-3052 (2) (c) provides that one-half the proceeds therefrom shall be allocated for school purposes, and the remaining one-half may be so allocated for such purpose by appropriate contract between the said Metropolitan Government and the city or cities and towns entitled to receive distribution of same from the State of Tennessee;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Mayor of the City of Belle Meade is hereby expressly authorized to negotiate with the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, and with the heads of government of the other cities within the area of said such Metropolitan Government to

make an agreement or agreements relative to same,

SECTION 2. In the event the Mayor shall, by such negotiation as is here-
inbefore provided, reach an agreement, or propose agreement with the
said Metropolitan Government and the other cities aforesaid, which he
considers to be in the best interest of the City of Belle Meade, and
which is in proper legal form, he shall recommend same to the Board of
Commissioners of the City of Belle Meade for approval.

SECTION 3. In the event the Mayor of Belle Meade shall negotiate an
agreement or agreements pursuant to this ordinance and shall recommend
same to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Belle Meade for
approval, such approval, if given, shall be indicated by a resolution
and adopted by the said Board of Commissioners at a regular quarterly
meeting of said Board, or at a special meeting of said Board, called
for the purpose of considering such agreements; a copy of such resolution
indicating approval, and certified by the Recorder of the City of Belle
Meade, and bearing the seal of the City affixed thereto, shall be
attached to such agreement as authentication and evidence of the authority
of the Mayor to sign such agreement on behalf of the City of Belle Meade.
