

ORDINANCE NO. 66-4

AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE A NEW STREET AND TO CHANGE THE NAME OF TWO EXISTING STREETS IN THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE TO LYNWOOD LANE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Those certain streets shown on the major street plan of the City of Belle Meade and designated as First Street and Second Street, which extend in a general easterly and westerly direction between their intersections at their western termini with Lynwood Boulevard and at their eastern termini, and connecting with the northerly and southerly termini of a new street, shown on the subdivision plan recently approved by the Municipal Planning Commission of the City of Belle Meade and designated as Lynwood Lane, shall be renamed and redesignated as Lynwood Lane.

SECTION 2: The City Manager is authorized and directed to advise the United States Post Office Department, Metropolitan Department of Public Works, and other public officials concerned, of the change in names herein made, and is further directed to cause proper signs to be erected at appropriate locations so as to advise the general public of the name and location of Lynwood Lane.
