

ORDINANCE NO. 67-2

AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE THE NASHVILLE RECORD,
A LEGAL NEWSPAPER PUBLISHED WEEKLY AND IN
GENERAL CIRCULATION IN DAVIDSON COUNTY, TENNESSEE,
AS THE OFFICIAL JOURNAL OF THE CITY OF BELLE
MEADE, AND REQUIRING THAT ALL OFFICIAL ADVERTISING
REQUIRED BY LAW BE PUBLISHED THEREIN.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That, WHEREAS, for many years The Nashville Record, a legal newspaper published weekly in Davidson County, Tennessee, and in general circulation throughout said County, has been referred to in ordinances adopted by the City as the official journal, and has been used as the newspaper of the City for publication of invitations for bids on public work, and as a means of giving notice to the citizens of Belle Meade, and to the general public, of all matters, notice of which by published advertisement is required by law or ordinance,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE NASHVILLE RECORD shall be and is hereby designated as the official journal of the City of Belle Meade.

SECTION 2. All matters required by law or by City Ordinance to be published by the City of Belle Meade in the conduct of its affairs shall be published in The Nashville Record, and all notices heretofore so published shall be deemed to have been published as required by law or ordinance in the official journal of the City of Belle Meade.


SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
