

ORDINANCE 2012-4

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 15-703
OF THE BELLE MEADE MUNICIPAL CODE, ENTITLED
"Illegal Parking"

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE, as follows:

On the recommendation of the of Chief of Police and the Board of Commissioners, the City of Belle Meade acts to amend its Municipal Code, Title 15, Chapter 7, Section 703 of the Belle Meade Municipal Code (the "Code"), entitled "Illegal Parking" to delete the reference to a court date within ten days of the citation and to insert that the court date shall be the regularly scheduled dates of the meeting of the City Court of the City of Belle Meade as reflected on the citation. Accordingly, Section 15-703 of the Belle Meade Municipal Code that currently reads as follows:

15-703. Illegal parking. Whenever any motor vehicle without a driver is found parked or stopped in violation of any of the restrictions imposed by this title, the officer finding such vehicle shall take its license number and may take any other information displayed on the vehicle which may identify its user, and shall conspicuously affix to such vehicle a citation for the driver and/or owner to answer for the violation within ten (10) days during the hours at a place specified in the citation. In the event the owner shall appeal and waive his right to a judicial hearing after ten (10) days from the date of violation but before a warrant for his arrest is issued, his fine shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00); if such appearance shall be made after issuance of warrant but before service of same, the fine shall include the cost of issuing the warrant.

Is hereby amended to read as follows:

15-703. Illegal parking. Whenever any motor vehicle without a driver is found parked or stopped in violation of any of the restrictions imposed by this title, the officer finding such vehicle shall take its license number and may take any other information displayed on the vehicle which may identify its user, and shall conspicuously affix to such vehicle a citation for the driver and/or owner to answer for the violation at the meeting of the City Court of the City of Belle Meade on the day and during the hours specified in the citation. In the event the owner shall appear and waive his right to a judicial hearing but before a warrant for his arrest is issued, his fine shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00); if such appearance shall be made after issuance of warrant but before service of same, the fine shall include the cost of issuing the warrant.


Section 2: This Ordinance shall become effective fifteen days after its passage.


