ORDINANCE NO. 21

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE HOURS OF OPERATION OF ESTABLISHMENTS SELLING BEER WITHIN THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE AS FOLLOWS:

That the sale, giving away or consumption of beer, either in retail or wholesale quantities on, at, or in connection with any establishment holding a permit for the sale of beer shall be unlawful between the hours of 12 midnight and 6:00 A.M. on week days and between the hours of 12 midnight and 1:00 P.M. on Sunday.

Section I: That this ordinance shall be published in the Nashville Banner, (the official newspaper of Belle Meade) immediately after its final passage.

Section II: That this ordinance shall take effect from and after its final passage, the welfare of the City of Belle Meade requiring it.

Section III: That the violation of this ordinance shall constitute a misdemeanor punishable by fine not exceeding \$25.00 for each separate offense.
