ORDINANCE NO. 30

An ordinance to change the name of a certain street in the City of Belle Meade from Highland Place to Westview Avenue.

WHEREAS, it has become apparent that the street running north and south between Harding Place and Tyne Boulevard,
and parallel to Lynnwood Boulevard, in the City of Belle
Meade, now called Highland Place, bears a confusing name,
in that there are other streets in Davidson County bearing
the same name and postal zone number; and,

WHEREAS, said Highland Place runs in the same general direction as a street known as Westview Avenue, which is better known to the public, and less likely to be confused with other streets in Davidson County, none of which bear the same name; and,

WHEREAS, Highland Place is very nearly a continuation of the said Westview Avenue from its southern terminus to Tyne Boulevard;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE, AS FOLLOWS:

That a certain street now running north and south between the southerly margin of Harding Place and the northerly margin of Tyne Boulevard, all within the corporate limits of the City of Belle Meade, known previously as Highland Place, be and the same shall hereafter be known, named and designated as Westview Avenue.
