

ORDINANCE NUMBER 34

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AN ORDINANCE ADOPTED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE, TENNESSEE, ON THIRD READING FEBRUARY 6, 1941, ENTITLED ' AN ORDINANCE NAMING A CERTAIN STREET IN THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE " LOHCIN LANE " ', SO AS TO CHANGE THE NAME OF SAID STREET TO "WEST TYNE DRIVE".


WHEREAS, a certain street running from a point on the northwesterly side of Belle Meade Boulevard between its intersection with Tyne Road and Chickering Road, in a northwesterly direction to the westerly corporate limits of the City of Belle Meade has been officially known and designated as "LOHCIN LANE"; and

WHEREAS, said name has caused considerable confusion to the public inasmuch as said street was formerly known as "West Tyne Drive", and is so shown on all maps and plats and real estate deeds of property lying adjacent thereto; and

WHEREAS, all of the residents of the area served by said Lohcin Lane are desirous that the name be re-changed to West Tyne Drive or have so indicated to the City Manager and other officials of the City of Belle Meade:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE AS FOLLOWS:

That certain street running from a point in the westerly margin of Belle Meade Boulevard, within the corporate limits of the City of Belle Meade, between the intersections therewith of Tyne Road and Chickering Road, in a northwesterly direction to the westerly corporate limits of the City of Belle Meade, previously known and designated as as "LOHCIN LANE" be, and the same shall hereafter be known, named and designated as West Tyne Drive, and all ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.
