


ORDINANCE NO. 36


AN ORDINANCE TO CLOSE, VACATE AND ABANDON A PORTION OF
A CERTAIN STREET OR RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE CITY OF BELLE
MEADE, KNOWN AS GLENSIDE AVENUE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That certain portion of a dedicated but unpaved street, shown on the major street plan of the City of Belle Meade, filed in the Register's Office of Davidson County, Tennessee, on May 10, 1946, which lies between Lynnwood Boulevard and a paved, unnamed street running in a northeasterly direction from Lynnwood Boulevard between the property of T. C. McEwen and M. E. Nellums, said street being known as Glenside Avenue, and the portion thereof being four fifty (450) feet, in length, more or less, and fifty (50) feet, in width, is hereby declared closed, vacated and abandoned.
