


ORDINANCE NUMBER 38


AN ORDINANCE TO CLOSE, VACATE AND ABANDON A PORTION OF A CERTAIN STREET OR RIGHT-OF-WAY IN THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE KNOWN AS DUPONT AVENUE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE AS FOLLOWS:


"Section 1. That certain portion of a dedicated but unpaved street, shown on the major street plan of the City of Belle Meade, filed in the Register's Office of Davidson County, Tennessee on May 10, 1946, which extends in a northerly direction from its intersection with a dedicated but unpaved street known as Third Street 300 feet from said Third Street, said street being known as DuPont Avenue and being 50 feet in width is hereby declared closed, vacated and abandoned."




