ORDINANCE No. 41

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AN ORDINANCE ADOPTED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE TENNESSEE ON THIRD READING SEPTEMBER 6, 1940, ENTITLED 'AN ORDINANCE TO FIX THE DATES ON WHICH THE TERMS OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE TENNESSEE BEGIN AND END; TO PROVIDE FOR THE HOLDING OF ELECTIONS OF COMMISSIONERS; TO PROVIDE FOR THE HOLDING OF REGISTRATIONS OF VOTERS IN THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE TENNESSEE; AND TO AUTHORIZE THE PAYMENT OF EXPENSES OF SUCH ELECTIONS AND REGISTRATIONS' SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR THE PLACE OF HOLDING THE ELECTIONS OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 15 adopted by the City of Belle Meade Tennessee on third reading on the 6th day of September, 1940, entitled 'An Ordinance to fix the dates on which the terms of Commissioners of the City of Belle Meade Tennessee begin and end; to provide for the holding of elections of Commissioners; to provide for the holding of registrations of voters in the City of Belle Meade Tennessee; and to authorize the payment of expenses of such elections and registrations' be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

Strike out all of Section 4 thereof, and insert in lieu of the stricken out provision a new Section 4, as follows:

Section 4 x a: All elections conducted under the provisions of this ordinance shall be opened and held at such place within the City of Belle Meade as the Board of Commissioners may by resolution designate, and inform the Election Commissioner of Davidson County thereof not less than fifteen (15) days prior to the day such election is to be held.

Section 4 x b: All registrations conducted and held under the provisions of this ordinance shall be held at such place as the Election Commissioner of Davidson County, Tennessee may direct.

Section 2. Strike out that portion of Section 3 thereof, the same being the sentence commencing with the words 'a supplemental registration' and ending with the words 'a Commissioner or Commissioners'."
