ORDINANCE NO. 6

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAKING OF A CONTRACT FOR THE MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF THE STREETS AND ROADS IN THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to prepare or have prepared specifications providing for the maintenance and repair of the public streets and roads within the corporate limits of the City of Belle Meade for a period of one year; to advertise for bids for performing such work, including the furnishing of necessary materials, by one publication in the Nashville Record, a newspaper published in the City of Nashville, Tennessee, requiring all bids to be in the hands of the City Manager not later than noon of the tenth day after said advertisement appears, said advertisement to contain such provisions as are required by law; and at the time provided for opening bids, to award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder if in the judgment of the Commissioners and City Manager, it is advisable to do so, provided that said bidder complies with legal requirements. The Mayor is authorized, empowered and directed to execute, in the name of the City of Belle Meade, a contract with the said lowest bidder in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance and the laws of the State of Tennessee, if and when the contract is awarded by the Commissioners and the City Manager.

SECTION 2: Because of the fact that many of the streets and roads in the City of Belle Meade are becoming badly worn and are being severely damaged because of failure to repair holes which are appearing in the surface of the streets and roads, it is hereby declared that an emergency exists. Be it, therefore, ordained that this Ordinance take effect from and after the date of its passage.
