Be It Further Resolved, that all checks, drafts, notes or orders drawn against said account be signed by the City Recorder and countersigned by the Mayor if he is available, otherwise by the Vice-Mayor whose signature shall be duly certified to said Bank, and that no checks, drafts, notes or orders, drawn against said Bank shall be valid unless so signed. This resulction to be nunc pro tunc.
