

Resolution 1942-02





"When the City of Belle Meade was incorporated in 1938, Mr. Charles W. Warterfield was chosen as its first Recorder. He served ably in this position until a reorganization of the City's affairs combined the office of Recorder with the office of City Manager.

"In 1940 he was elected by the citizens of Belle Meade as a Commissioner, and was chosen by the Board of Commissioners as Vice Mayor of the City. After having served in this office for nearly two years, his removal from the City of Belle Meade made it necessary that he resign.

"His thorough knowledge of business and of municipal finance, and his sound judgment have been of inestimable value to the City and to the Board of Commissioners. It is with sincere regret that we find it necessary to accept his resignation because of the requirement of the applicable statute.

"BE IT RESOLVED, THEREFORE, That this Resolution be spread on the Minutes of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Belle Meade, Tennessee, and that a copy be furnished to Mrs. Charles W. Warterfield."
