



Resolution 1947-02


RESOLVED, that, whereas the purchase, installation and maintenance of street lights at certain intersections and bus stops along Belle Meade Boulevard, for illumination at night is necessary for the promotion of the public safety, welfare and interest, the City Manager is directed to advertise for bids on the purchase, installation and maintenance for one (1) year of fifteen (15) suitable lighting units, on Belle Meade Boulevard, in a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Belle Meade; and, in the event no bids are received, or the bids received are deemed unacceptable, the City Manager shall then ascertain, by his own methods, the best price for such project that can be obtained and proceed to purchase and install said lighting units, at a cost not to exceed \$3,900.00, the City Treasurer having certified that there are sufficient funds on hand to make payment therefor.




