

Resolution 1949-01


WHEREAS, the Federal Housing and Rent Act of 1949 (Chapter 42- Public Law 31) provides for the termination of rent control in any incorporated city, upon the adoption of a resolution of its governing body, after the holding of a public hearing, and after approval of such resolution by the Governor of the State, and transmittal of said resolution and approval to the Housing Expediter, and

WHEREAS, such public hearing is required to be held after ten days notice, and


WHEREAS, certain owners of housing accommodations located within the corporate limits of the City of Belle Meade have petitioned the Commissioners of this City, requesting that a resolution be adopted calling for a public hearing, as provided in Section 204 (j) (3) of the Housing and Rent Act of 1949;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE That, on the 25th day of July, 1949, at the Belle Meade Country Club, in the City of Belle Meade, beginning at 7:30 P.M., and continuing thereafter from day to day, as in the opinion of the Mayor is necessary, under the chairmanship of the Mayor, a public hearing before the Commissioners in session assembled, be held for the purpose of considering the advisability of terminating rent control in the City of Belle Meade;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That the chairman give notice of said public hearing by publishing said notice at least once in the Nashville Tennessean and Nashville Banner; such publications to appear at least ten (10) days prior to the date of the hearing.
