

Resolution 1949-02

"A RESOLUTION adopted for the purpose of terminating the provisions of the Housing and Rent Act of 1949, and the ending of rent control within the corporate limits of the City of Belle Meade, there no longer existing such a shortage in rental housing accommodations as to require rent control in said City.

WHEREAS, pursuant to notice published in the Nashville Banner and the Nashville Tennessean, both being newspapers of general circulation in Davidson County and the City of Belle Meade, Tennessee, on July 13, 1949, a public hearing was held on July 25, 1949, more than ten days after such publication of notice, at the Belle Meade Country Club in the City of Belle Meade, under the Chairmanship of the Mayor of said City, in order that it might be determined whether there exists such a shortage in rental housing accommodations as to require rent control within said City; and

WHEREAS, as the result of the said public hearing, and careful study of the stenographic record of the evidence given at said hearing, the Commissioners of the City of Belle Meade, being and constituting the governing body of the said City, hereby find that there no longer exists such a shortage in rental housing accommodations as to require the continuance of rent control in the City of Belle Meade, this, their finding


being based upon said public hearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE, That there no longer exists such a shortage in rental housing accommodations as to require rent control in the city of Belle Meade, Tennessee, and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution, certified to be a full, true and complete copy by the Recorder of the City of Belle Meade, be forwarded to the Governor of the State of Tennessee for his approval and transmittal to the National Housing Expediter, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That upon approval by the Governor of the State of Tennessee, this resolution be transmitted to the National Housing Expediter, administering the said Rent Control Law, to the end that such rent control may be declared terminated within the corporate limits of the City of Belle Meade, all as provided by the Housing and Rent Act of 1949."


Vice-Mayor McDonald seconded the motion. The vote resulted as follows: YEA: Mayor Gibson, Vice-Mayor McDonald, Commissioner Wallace.
