



Resolution 1950-03

The City Manager next announced that he had been notified of the completion of a certain street in the City of Belle Meade shown on the major street plan filed in the County Register's Office on May 20, 1946 as "Third Street". The City Manager further announced that he had inspected said Third Street during the time of its construction and since its completion had been announced and that it fulfilled requirements of the Municipal Planning Commission as to length and width and the requirements of the Board of Commissioners as to construction. Thereupon, by motion duly made, seconded and voted upon, it was unanimously


RESOLVED, that a certain street running in a generally east and west direction, with its westerly terminus on the easterly margin of Lynwood Boulevard and its easterly terminus consisting of a dead-end with turn-around approximately 850 feet in length, said westerly terminus being 400 feet, more or less, north of the junction of Lynwood Boulevard and Westview Avenue, all in the City of Belle Meade, be and is hereby in all things accepted as a street of the City of Belle Meade and its name shall be and is Third Street.
