

Resolution 1952-03

"WHEREAS, on Saturday, October 18, 1952, a crime of violence, armed robbery, was committed in the City of


"Belle Meade, in the home of one of its citizens, against him and his family and other citizens of the said City, of Davidson County, the State of Tennessee, and of other states; and

"WHEREAS, the City of Belle Meade regards it as its duty to take all appropriate measures within its power to bring the offenders to justice, to recover the stolen property, and to discourage future crimes;


"NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Unanimously Resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Belle Meade, that the City Treasurer of the City of Belle Meade be and he is hereby authorized and directed to pay, out of emergency funds of the City, to the order of such person or persons as the District Attorney General of Tennessee for Davidson County may direct, the sum of FIVE HUNDRED (\$500.00) DOLLARS, for services rendered or information furnished by such person or persons in the arrest, apprehension and conviction of the persons who committed said crime of violence on the date and in the place aforesaid."

Upon passage of the foregoing resolution, the Mayor then directed the City Attorney to forward a copy of same to the Honorable J. Carlton Loser as evidence of the action taken by the City of Belle Meade in regard to the robbery.


There being no further business, the meeting was then adjourned.
