




Resolution 1952-04

Mayor Gibson announced that the next order of business was the consideration by the Board of a letter from Messrs. W. W. Morehead, Jr. and Louis Farrell, Jr., dated December 12, 1952, wherein Messrs. Morehead and Farrell stated that as Senior Warden and Junior Warden, respectively, for St. George's Church, they offered to purchase the Reagan property, including the service station and City Hall property owned by the City of Belle Meade for Thirty-seven Thousand Five Hundred (\$37,500.00) Dollars. Mr. Gibson announced that he had stated to Messrs. Morehead and Farrell that approximately Forty-four Thousand (\$44,000.00) Dollars had been invested by the City of Belle Meade in this property. Thereupon, consideration, and discussion, upon motion duly made, seconded, and voted upon, it was unanimously

RESOLVED, that the offer of Messrs. W. W. Morehead, and Louis Farrell, Jr. as Senior and Junior Warden of St. George's Church regarding the purchase of the service station and City Hall of the City of Belle Meade, be and is hereby not accepted by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Belle Meade, and that such offer be allowed to expire.
