

Resolution 1953-03

"BE IT RESOLVED, by The Municipal Planning Commission of the City of Belle Meade, in special meeting on the 14th day of September, 1953, and having heard and fully considered the petition of the Belle Meade Country Club, and the testimony of witnesses in support of same, and it appearing to the said Commission that the result requested in the said petition would require the repeal of one of the basic zoning ordinances and a departure from one of the basic purposes and principles, for which incorporation of the area included in the City was originally sought, and to preserve which most subsequent action of this Commission has been directed, that the prayer of said petition in so far as a favorable recommendation by the Municipal Planning Commission is concerned, be denied, and that the City Recorder shall so notify both the petitioner, Belle Meade Country Club, and the Board of Commissioners of the City of Belle Meade.

Then followed the report of the City Recorder on the action of the Municipal Planning Commission, and at the end of the discussion Mr. Hutton moved the Board that:

"Without further consideration of the merits of the petition of the Belle Meade Country Club, it be resolved that the recommendation of the Municipal Planning Commission upon the petition of the Belle Meade Country Club be accepted and that no ordinance be considered to amend the present zoning ordinance."
