


Resolution 1954-03 1


The Mayor announced that the first matter for attention of the meeting was a request for authorization to lay a drainage pipe along the easterly boundary of Bellevue Drive, East, in the City of Belle Meade, along the westerly boundary of the Palmer School property. After discussion, in which it was brought out that many children whose parents are citizens of the City of Belle Meade attend Palmer School and it is the duty of the City to do such things as may be necessary to secure the welfare of Palmer School. Upon motion duly made, seconded, and voted upon it was unanimously

RESOLVED, that the City Manager be, and is hereby, authorized and directed to expend up to Twelve Hundred (\$1200.00) Dollars of the funds of the City of Belle Meade resulting from the 1¢ Gas Tax apportionment to pay for the installation of a sixteen inch metal culvert along the easterly boundary of the right-of-way of Bellevue Drive, East, and along the westerly boundary of the right-of-way of Palmer School where the two boundaries touch, in order to provide drainage for that portion of Bellevue Drive, East, and so as to prevent the flooding and washing away of certain grounds and improvements of Palmer School, and any excess from said funds to be returned to the 1¢ road tax fund.
