## Resolution 1960-07

The Mayor next announced that an agreement had been prepared by the City Attorney between the Sheriff of Davidson County and the City of Belle Meade providing for the lodging of prisoners of the City of Belle Meade, primarily persons who had refused or been unable to pay fines assessed for traffic and other offenses within the jurisdiction of the Recorder's Court of the City, and providing for payment of the expenses of keeping such prisoners by the City, and providing credit for prisoner's work, and asked the City Attorney to read same to the meeting, which was done. Upon conclusion of the reading it was moved by Vice Mayor Teas, seconded by Commissioner Smith, voted upon and

unanimously

RESOLVED that the agreement between the City of
Belle Meade and Leslie Jett, Sheriff of Davidson County,
providing for the keeping of prisoners of the City of
Belle Meade by the Sheriff of Davidson County be and the
same is hereby in all things ratified and approved, and
the appropriate officials of the City are authorized to
execute same on behalf of the City.
