M. or July 16, 1951, then, in that event, this resolution shal not be effective, and the lease shall continue to be bir ing upon the Lessees; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City Lanager and/or the City Attorney of the City of Belle Meade be, and are her by, authorized and directed to ascertain whether the Les sees have complied with the conditions of this resolution and, in the event said officials shall find that the Les have complied with said resolution, and shall so inform the Lessees, then this cancellation shall be effective as he inabove set forth; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution t transmitted to the said Lessees by the City Attorney.
