

Resolution 1956-03

he and the City Manager had prepared a diagram showing and designating the locations of fifteen additional fire hydrants to be installed by the Nashville Suburban Utility District pursuant to contract with the City during the coming year. The Vice-Mayor further stated that the 22 hydrants installed during 1955 had cost a total of approximately \$7,200.00, or approximately \$325.00 per hydrant. He further stated that the sum of \$5,000.00 which is provided in the disbursing schedule for 1956 for the fire hydrant program should be adequate to take care of the 15 hydrants proposed to be installed during the calendar year 1956. After further discussion, and upon motion duly made, seconded and voted upon, the following resolution was adopted:

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Manager with the advice of the Vice-Mayor, F. B. Warfield, is hereby authorized and directed to execute a contract with the Nashville Suburban Utility District for the installation of fifteen (15) additional fire hydrants, upon the terms as provided by ordinance, at locations designated by the City Manager under the supervision of the Vice-Mayor, funds having been provided therefor in the disbursing schedule heretofore adopted and approved by the Board of Commissioners for the calendar year 1956; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the contract for installation of fire hydrants between the City of Belle Meade and the Nashville Suburban Utility District this day presented to the Board be and is hereby in all things ratified and approved.
