

Resolution 1956-04

The Mayor announced that the next matter for consideration was the program of repairs of roads and streets of the city for the year 1956. The Mayor showed to the meeting a road program proposal submitted by Interstate Construction Company, at prices estimated in accordance with the contract for supply of materials and labor currently in effect between the Interstate Construction Company and the city, such program consisting of approximately twelve items. The Mayor further stated that in his opinion only about six of the items were required to be acted upon this year, and that the others were not pressing and would not deteriorate before the program of 1957 could be begun. After further discussion, upon motion duly made by Commissioner Bell, and seconded by Vice Mayor Warfield, it was unanimously

RESOLVED, That the Board of Commissioners does hereby appropriate the sum of \$10,000.00 to be used for repair and maintenance of the roads and streets of the City of Belle Meade for the calendar year 1956, and  
FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager notify the Interstate Construction Company of this action, and  
FURTHER RESOLVED that the items to be completed by the expenditure of such funds be specified by an additional resolution of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Belle Meade.
