

Resolution 1956-05

The Mayor next announced that the insurance firm of Davis and Gordon had submitted to the City proposal for coverage of all the policemen of the City under the full provisions of the Workmen's Compensation Act of the State of Tennessee at an annual premium of \$525.00, and further stated that the Workmen's Compensation Law provides not only for payment of a lump sum in the event of death or permanent disability of an injured person covered by the law, but also provides payment of compensation for time lost from work, and for further stated amounts in the event of specified injuries. The Mayor further stated that all the members of the police force were currently covered by the United States Social Security Law, the City having voluntarily submitted to the coverage of such law in 1951. Thereupon, following further discussion, upon motion of Commissioner Bell, and seconded by Vice Mayor Warfield, it was unanimously:

RESOLVED, That the City Manager be and is hereby authorized and directed to contract for the issuance of Workmen's Compensation insurance covering all regular employees of the City of Belle Meade, at a cost not to exceed \$600.00 per annum, which sum is hereby appropriated from the general funds of the City of Belle Meade to pay for such insurance.
