## Resolution 1956-07

The Mayor announced that it had been suggested by the Davidson County Election Commission that an allowance be made in the expenses of the election so as to pay all of those who had served as officials, whether Registrars, Clerks, Judges or machine operators a minimum of \$10.00. Commissioner Bell moved that a resolution be adopted providing for such payment and the motion was seconded by Vice Mayor Warfield. The vote thereon resulted as follows: Yea, Mayor Gibson, Vice Mayor Warfield and Commissioner Bell. Mayor Gibson then instructed the City Attorney to communicate with the Davidson County Election Commission and inform them of this action of the Board of Commissioners.

The Mayor then asked if there was any further business to come before the meeting and upon receiving replies in the negative declared same adjourned.
