tion were the petitions for annexation by residents of Davidson County living on or adjoining Chickering Road and Chickering Lane, and by owners of territory lying adjacent to the eastern boundary of the City of Belle Meade, near the easterly terminus of Chickering Lane. After discussion, the following resolution was proposed:

BE IT RESOLVED That, where as a petition having been received signed by residents and owners of property immediately adjoining the boundaries of the City of Belle Meade on the south, along Chickering Road and Chickering Lane, and on the east, at the easterly terminus of Chickering Lane, asking that certain described territory be annexed by the City of Belle Meade, and it appearing to the Beard of Commissioners that any course of action in the premises should be based upon study, report and recommendation of the Municipal Planning Commission of the City of Belle Meade; and

THEREFORE, it is the decision of the Board of Commissioners that the petition for annexation be referred to the Municipal Planning Commission of the City for study, report and recommendation, and that no action on said petition be taken pending receipt of such report from the said Municipal Planning Commission.
