

Resolution 1957-05

The Mayor announced that he was in receipt of a letter from Mr. Francis B. Warfield, Commissioner of the City of Belle Meade, dated February 18, 1957, in which Mr. Warfield submitted his resignation as such Commissioner. The Mayor announced that he had no alternative but regretfully to entertain a motion to accept Commissioner Warfield's resignation, which motion was made by Mr. John H. Teas. Motion having been seconded and voted upon, the vote resulted as follows: Yea, Mayor Bell, Vice Mayor Teas. The Vice-Mayor then asked the City Attorney to present to the meeting appropriate resolution recognizing Mr. Warfield's service to the City of Belle Meade which was read as follows:

"WHEREAS, Francis B. Warfield has this day submitted his resignation as a Commissioner of the City of Belle Meade; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Warfield, as a member of the Municipal Planning Commission and Board of Zoning Appeals has rendered outstanding, unselfish and splendid service to the City of Belle Meade since its foundation; and




"NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Belle Meade that this expression of appreciation and recognition of the splendid service to the City of Francis B. Warfield be spread upon the official journal of the City and a copy thereof furnished to Mr. Warfield's family.
