## Resolution 1957-06

Vice Mayor Teas then stated to the meeting that he recommended the appointment and designation of the Third National Bank as depository and custodian for the City in conducting an account for the City so as to take care of the purchase and sale of U. S. Treasury Bonds as might be decided upon by the Board of Commissioners and further stated that the Board of Commissioners, or any one of them, when joined by the City Manager, should be designated as authorized to accept delivery and execute orders for sales of such bonds as determined by the Board of Commissioners. Thereupon, a resolution in the form proposed by the Third National Bank in Nashville was presented to the meeting and adopted by unanimous vote and a copy thereof ordered appended to these

minutes and the certification thereof by the Mayor and City Recorder authorized.
