Resolution 1958-04

The Mayor then called upon the City Attorney to state his opinion as to whether additional measures were necessary to prevent the unauthorized construction of the road to link the proposed subdivision with the existing terminus of Chickering Lane, and the City Attorney replied that before the other measures became fully effective it might be necessary to commence legal proceedings in Chancery Court to seek an injunction to prevent such construction of the road and he recommended that authority be given by the Board of Commissioners to the Mayor, the Chairman of the Municipal Planning Commission and the City Manager to institute such legal proceedings if same should become necessary. Thereupon, it was moved by Vice Mayor Teas and seconded by Commissioner Hale and upon ballot unanimously

RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Belle Meade,
Sam Davis Bell, the Chairman of the Municipal Planning
Commission, Robert C. Webster, and the City Manager,
W. T. Mallison, or their successors in office, be and the
same are hereby authorized and directed to institute
any and all such legal proceedings as may be necessary
to prevent the construction of a road in the City of
Belle Meade without the approval of the Municipal Planning
Commission, and to prevent any and all other encroachments
upon the legal rights of the City of Belle Meade, as the
said Mayor, Chairman of the Municipal Planning Commission
and City Manager may be advised to do by the City Attorney
and Special Counsel for the City of Belle Meade.
