


Resolution 1958-06


... stated that inasmuch as Captain Mallison's long period of service with the City merited recognition, upon his retirement, of the gratitude of the City and of his continued remuneration, in some degree, by the City for his services, he had asked the City Attorney to prepare and read to the meeting another resolution, which was done as follows:

"BE IT RESOLVED, that, from and after the date of the retirement of W. T. Mallison, ^{the} City Treasurer of the City of Belle Meade be and is hereby authorized and directed to pay to W. T. Mallison the sum of ONE HUNDRED TWENTY FIVE (\$125.00) DOLLARS on the last day of each calendar month for a period of twenty-four (24) calendar months as retirement compensation for his services; provided, however, that payments hereinabove provided shall be payable only to W. T. Mallison and shall not be assignable nor transferrable, nor shall same be payable to any other person in the event of the death of the said W. T. Mallison within the said period of twenty-four (24) months."


