

Resolution 1959-02

The Mayor then announced that, in view of the expected absence of the City Attorney from the City for a period of several weeks in the coming summer it would be appropriate to consider the election of an Assistant City Attorney, in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 59-4 which had just been passed on Third Reading, and asked the City Attorney if he had any recommendations. He stated that he recommended the appointment of James R. Tuck, of Iroquois Avenue, who had been a resident of the City of Belle Meade for several years, and was well qualified to attend to the City's business. The City Manager stated that he was happy to recommend the selection of Mr. Tuck and upon motion of Mr. Teas, seconded by Mr. Smith and voted upon it was unanimously

RESOLVED that James R. Tuck be and is hereby elected Assistant City Attorney of the City of Belle Meade to serve with the City Attorney during his term of office, ending in December 1960, or until his successor should be qualified and elected, and to serve at such compensation as should be fixed for services rendered."
