


**Resolution 1974-03**

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Belle Meade, that, being of the opinion that the present route of Woodmont Boulevard and White Bridge Road is the best and most feasible route for the location of that segment of Briley Parkway which remains unconstructed in this area, and that the use of such route will obviate the necessity for dedicating large additional areas of land to road and highway purposes, and the accompanying dislocation and heavy expense,

NOW, THEREFORE, it does favor the relocation of that portion of the proposed route of Briley Parkway which lies along the northeasterly boundary of the City of Belle Meade so as to remove same from immediate proximity to the said boundary and to eliminate the possible construction of an interchange with Harding Road within the boundaries of the City of Belle Meade.
