

Resolution 1975-02

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE TO CLAIM EXEMPTION OF SECTION 7 (K) OF THE FAIR LABOR STANDARDS ACT RELATIVE TO OVERTIME WAGES FOR PUBLIC SAFETY PERSONNEL.

WHEREAS, Section (K) of the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, as amended, requires an affirmative declaration of the Board of Commissioners to claim the exemption of said section in order to make overtime wages applicable to public safety personnel only for time worked in excess of the maximum hours permitted per designated work period in Section 7 (K) as implemented in 29 CFR 553.12; and


WHEREAS, Section (K) requires that such a work period for public safety employees shall be at least seven days, but not more than twenty-eight days in length for the exemption to be valid; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has, after due consideration, determined that it is to the best interest of the City of Belle Meade to claim said exemption;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Belle Meade that it is the intention of the Board of Commissioners to claim and the Board of Commissioners hereby claims, the exemption of Section 7 (K) of the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938, as amended, so as to make law enforcement personnel eligible for overtime wages only for time worked in excess of the maximum total permitted per designated work period.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the law enforcement employees of the City of Belle Meade shall work on a work period of twenty-eight days in length.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution shall affect only those law enforcement personnel who are eligible for the Section 7 (K) exemption, and that the City Manager is directed to notify all affected of this action.
