

Resolution 1976-02

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, pursuant to the adoption of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972, P. L. 92-500, the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, Tennessee, has made application for a Federal Construction Grant to construct the Richland Creek Interceptor Sewer.


WHEREAS, in order to meet the requirements of the United States Environmental Protection Agency governing the award of this Grant the City of Belle Meade must express its intent to provide lateral sewers into the area of the City of Belle Meade to be served by the Richland Creek Interceptor Sewer Project within a reasonable period of time after the award of the Contract to construct the Richland Creek Interceptor Sewer.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE:

That the City of Belle Meade will have constructed and pay off the lateral sewers needed to provide sewerage service to the area within the City of Belle Meade to be served by the Richland Creek Interceptor Sewer Project, Metro Project No. 66-S-72B.

That the lateral sewer construction will be initiated within a reasonable time after the award of the Federal Construction Grant on the Richland Creek Interceptor Sewer and the contracting by the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County, Tennessee, for the construction of this project.

That certified copies of this Resolution be submitted to the United States Environmental Protection Agency evidencing the intent of the City of Belle Meade to be obligated for the herein stated lateral sewerage service expansion.
