

Resolution 1980-01

WHEREAS, the City of Belle Meade, Davidson County, Tennessee, wishes to construct a collector sewer system to serve its citizens, not only to abate stream pollution but to minimize health risks; and

WHEREAS, the City of Belle Meade has attempted since 1972 to provide for the construction of a collector sewer system; and

WHEREAS, construction of such facilities has been delayed in part by Public Law 92-500 and because of the planning requirements of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Belle Meade has now caused to be prepared construction drawings and specifications for the construction of a collector sewer system;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners:

1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file a request on behalf of the City of Belle Meade with the United States Environmental Protection Agency for grant funds to assist in financing the aforementioned project;
2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information and execute such documents as the United States Environmental Protection Agency may reasonably request which are herein authorized to be filed; and
3. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to negotiate and enter into a contract revision with the firm of Barge, Waggoner, Sumner and Cannon to provide engineering and inspection services during the construction of this project.
