



Resolution 1980-03


WHEREAS, the City of Belle Meade, Tennessee, desires to provide waste water facilities in the community in order to abate water pollution in and around the area; and


WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency, under Public Law 92-500, has made a grant offer to the City of Belle Meade, Tennessee, in the amount of Two Million One Hundred Thousand Dollars and No/100 (\$2,100,000.00);

NOW, THEREFORE, it is resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Belle Meade, Tennessee, that the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to accept the United States Environmental Protection Agency grant offer and to execute all documents appropriate and necessary for the acceptance of the grant offer and for the construction of an interceptor and pressurized waste water collection system in the Belle Meade-Richland Creek area.
