## RESOLUTION FOR TENTATIVE AWARD OF CONTRACT PRESSURE GRAVITY WASTEWATER SYSTEM CITY OF BELLE MEADE, TENNESSEE

Whereas; the City of Belle Meade desires to provide sewerage services to the residents within the City;

Whereas, the City of Belle Meade has an EPA grant offer in the amount of \$2,100,000.00;

Whereas, the City of Belle Meade has approved plans and specifications for the construction of a combination pressure-gravity wastewater system;

Whereas, the City of Belle Meade advertised for bidding of wastewater grinder pump stations with spare pumps, motors, and valves on Thursday, September 3, 1981;

Whereas, three bids were received from F.E. Myers Company, Hydromatic Pump Division, and A.B.S. Pumps, Inc.;

Whereas, F.E. Myers Company submitted the low responsive, responsible bid in the amount of \$658,625.00 for the EPA eligible pumps and \$375,775.00 for the EPA ineligible pumps with a total bid of \$1,050,000.00; and

Whereas, the engineering firm of Barge, Waggoner, Sumner and Cannon has recommended tentative award to F.E. Myers Company.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Mayor and Board of Commissioners do hereby make tentative award to F.E. Myers

Company, Division of McNeil Corporation, in the amount of

\$1,050,000.00. Said award shall be subject to and contingent upon the approval of the Tennessee Department of Public Health and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the availability of funds.
