A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 87-07 ESTABLISHING AMOUNTS OF FEES TO BE CHARGED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE FOR PERMIT APPLICATIONS AND OTHER FEES

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF BELLE MEADE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Resolution 84-06, establishing fees for building permits, is amended so as to set these fees as follows:

<u>Classification A:</u> New residences, accessary structures, and alterations or additions to existing structures other than those described below:

If new or additional walls or fences are required, the appropriate permit fee set in Classification E, shall also be required.

<u>Classification C:</u> For additions or alterations that require no plans and no more than one inspection. \$ 75.00

An amount equal to the above fees, shall be collected as a performance bond. This will be refunded to the owners after final inspection and acceptance.

Section 2. The above fees cover the normal and routine inspection plans review and services conducted by the office of the building inspector prior to and during construction.

For any additional services required to effect compliance with or enforcement of building and zoning codes in connection with construction under the permit granted, or made at the request of the applicant or owner, or otherwise deemed necessary by the building official, there shall be additional fees in the amount of direct expense to the City incurred in providing such services.
